We accept children from ages 5 and up for week long programs. The cost is \$175.00 per week. The day begins at 9:00 am and ends at 4:00 pm. Consideration will be given to part time schedules at \$40.00 per day.

Children will be divided into various groups to ensure the best possible experience.

Each child will need to bring:

Snacks, lunch, a water bottle, clothing appropriate for all weather (with a back-up supply), hat and shoes or boots for hiking and water exploration.

Bug spray and or sunblock should be applied before the day. More may be added at the parent's request.
